

Rules:

1. Competitors in the Pace Over Fences must jump all fences in numerical order. Colored ribbon marks the different courses. These will be coded on your map.
2. If you finish ahead of the Masters' time, penalties are deducted from your time; if you finish behind the Masters' time, penalties are added to your time. No penalties are incurred for falls or knockdowns. Please catch your horse, fix the fence, and remount!
3. Hard hats with chinstraps are required.
4. Contestants may choose their partners in advance. If you do not have a partner, come anyway and we will help pair you up.
5. Non-hunt members are required to sign a liability waiver before they compete.
6. Competitors may only enter one horse per class.
7. Riders meeting on the trail should keep to the right and proceed at a safe speed.
8. Slower teams should yield on request when being overtaken.
9. In case of bad weather, the organizers reserve the right to alter the course.
10. The organizers and property owners will not be responsible for loss or damage to persons or property.
