Responsibilities of Sponsors and Co-Sponsors

The continued excellence of the LLH depends, in large part, on the introduction of new members. The sponsor is responsible for the new member's training in safety and etiquette. Responsibilities include:

- Assess the candidate's riding, and feel confident that they are capable of hunting.
- Make certain that the candidate has received and read the LLH Member's Guide.
- Attend with, or ensure that the applicant attends an educational clinic prior to hunting.
- Accompany the candidate on their first five, or more, hunts as needed.
- Introduce the candidate to the Masters, Board members, and other Hunt members.
- Discuss and answer questions regarding Hunt events and requirements.

Remember, "Once a sponsor – always a sponsor." A new member cannot be expected to understand all the intricacies of the Hunt during their first year of membership.
