

# Long Lake Hounds Hunt Cup

**What: An Event Focused on Schooling to an Optimal Pace for Hunters, Eventer's, Jumpers /Non Jumpers Pony Club Riders and Horses of All Levels Welcome Over Brush Fences and on the Flat in the Pristine Hunt Country - Excellent Footing and Exceptional Viewing**

**When: Sunday October 2, 2011 10.00 – 3.00**

**Where: Pioneer Trail, Hamel, MN 55340**

## The Course

**A marked One Half Mile Course (= 1 Lap) will be laid out around a Hay Field. It will contain six 30" (2 ½ ft)-brush fences filled with Birch and Pine. Each competitor will be allowed a schooling round and then a competitive time round. All rounds will be done individually.**

## The Classes and Optimal Timing

- 1. "The Seabiscuit" Prelim/Training Level/LLH First Field – (1.5 miles/3 Laps @450 mpm) = Canter- Gallop 11.00 am Schooling/ 11.30 am Competition Round – Timed**
- 2. "The War Horse" Novice/LLH Mid Field - (1 mile/2 laps @400 mpm= Brisk Canter -12.00 pm Schooling/12.30 pm Competition Round**
- 3. "The Dawn Run" – Beginner Novice/LLH Second Field ½ mile/ 1 lap @ 300-350 mpm=trot to slow canter (with Fences)- 1.00 pm Schooling 1.30 pm Competition Round – timed**
- 4. "The Royal Academy" Non Jumping/LLH Second Field- 1 lap @300-350 mpm= trot to slow canter- 2.00 pm schooling/2.30 pm Competition Round – timed**

**Trophy and Six Ribbons to those closest to the optimal time in each division  
Cost per horse is \$30 Pony Clubbers \$20 – Liability Waivers will be required**
