

Guidelines of a Hunter's Pace



The Hunter's Pace is a great way to experience what it's like to be in a Hunt without the excitement of having the hounds to lead you. But it's important to understand just a couple of guidelines to keep everyone safe and for everyone to have a great time!



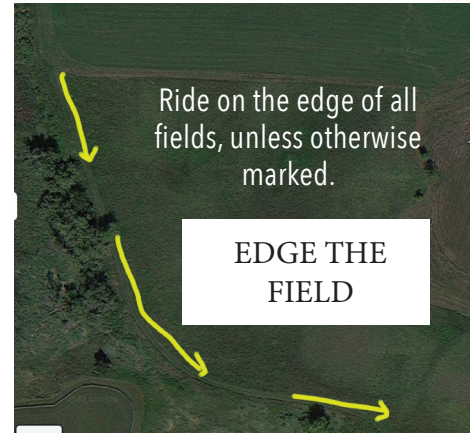
Drive slowly when horses are present.



Bring your own water, there is **NO WATER** for horses or people.



Tack up on the non-road side, if possible.



If you choose to warm up your horse before your 'tee' time, *please do so away from other horses*. We don't want to upset any horses while they are getting tacked up.



Park only on the side with other trailers so cars can still safely pass.

Please stay on the well marked trail. This is private property that you are riding on and we have been given special permission to ride *only* on the trails that are marked.



Clean up after your horse, we all want to be invited back again so leave no trace.



If you are going to take any of the jumps on course, only jump the jumps *once*. You never know who's coming up behind you. All jumps are optional.

Please call out for permission to pass on the course, and pass other teams with care. This could be a horse and/or rider's first Hunter's Pace, and we want everyone to have a safe and enjoyable ride.
