ABOUT THE HUNTER'S PACE:

A hunter pace is a competition where horses and riders follow a well marked trail. Prior to the event, Long Lake Hounds Masters ride the trail at the speed that the Field Hunter (trot/canter/gallop) and Hill Topper (walk/trot/canter) flights would go if they were hunting. The Masters pace time is the optimal time and considers the terrain and footing conditions. There will be 8-12 jumps spaced around the course, all of which are optional. Competitors go out in teams of two, three or no more than four to ride the trail. Each group of riders is timed. The group that comes closest to the optimal time for each division wins the competition.

THE DETAILS:

REGISTER at www.longlakehounds.com

DISTANCE: Approximately 4-5 mile marked course through rolling hills and beautiful woods

TEAMS: 2, 3, or no more than 4 riders

DIVISIONS: Field Hunter (Trot/Canter/Gallop), start times will be from approximately 9:00-10:00

Hill Topper (Walk/Trot/Canter), start times will be from approximately 10:00-11:00

COST: Member Adult Price: \$40

Member Junior Price: \$20 (under 19 years of age)

Non Member Adult Price: \$75

Non Member Junior Price: \$40 (under 19 years of age)

LOCATION: Watertown (*bring water for your horses, no water or bathrooms available*)

PRIZES: Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st-6th place teams.

NEW THIS YEAR: CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION OF THE LLH HUNTER'S PACE

In order to be eligible for the Champion and Reserve Champion in Field Hunter and Hill Topper Division in the pace series, the rider must compete in all three paces in the 2023 season (June 10, August 19, September 30) and have the lowest cumulative deviation from the optimum pace times. These ribbons will be presented at the Hunt Ball on Saturday, November 11th (you do not need to be present to win).

KEEPING EVERYONE SAFE:

All teams must register at www.longlakehounds.com. This will ensure that there will be appropriate distance between groups and less people on the roads tacking up at the same time. You will get a confirmation of your start time on the Friday before the Pace with the waiver, directions, parking and payment information.

ABOUT LLH:

The Long Lake Hounds, founded in 1959, is Minnesota's only hunt. The Long Lake Hounds is a "drag" hunt meaning it doesn't hunt or involve live foxes. A fox scent is dragged ahead of our pack of foxhounds to simulate the path a pursued fox might take through the woods and over fields. The hounds, at the direction of the Huntsman, find and follow the scent, leading members and guests on a great ride over private trails and fields that the club maintains.
